Koberoski will present “The Use of Trusts in Estate Planning” on Tuesday, May 24. Have you thought about what will happen to your estate when you are gone? Many of us believe we need not think about that now. In fact, there are many reasons you should start estate planning: tax consequences need be considered regardless of estate size; the need for an up-to-date will; careful consideration of charitable bequests and lifetime gifts; leaving a legacy within the community that will benefit future generations through planned giving; and the tax benefits of charitable trusts.

This presentation will introduce estate planning challenges, techniques and taxation. Koberoski’s seminar will also address charitable planning options that can keep farmers from facing significant tax implications as they move closer to retirement and begin transitioning out of farming. Charitable trusts and green unitrusts are popular planning tools that establish lifetime income for the donor, while accomplishing capital gain and ordinary income tax avoidance. Her message is beneficial for anyone interested in charitable giving, especially individuals who are approaching retirement or are in retirement, financial planners, insurance professionals and CPAs.
