**Madelia Community Hospital Foundation Announces
Three Renewable Healthcare Scholarships for 2019**

Madelia, Minn. – The Madelia Community Hospital Foundation will be offering three scholarships to area students through the Madelia Community Hospital Foundation. More than \$15,000 in scholarships have been awarded to Madelia and Lake Crystal area students since 2007.

Yoshiko Masters Memorial Scholarship

This \$1,000 renewable scholarship is offered for Madelia-area students interested in pursuing a degree in radiology or lab science. The scholarship is available to non-traditional students as well as high school seniors. Funding for the scholarship was provided by a generous donation to the Madelia Community Hospital Foundation from Pam and Michael Masters, in memory of Yoshiko Masters, a former MCHC laboratory employee.

MCH Foundation Healthcare Scholarship – Madelia

This \$500 renewable scholarship is available for Madelia High School seniors who are pursuing a career in healthcare. Students must be accepted in an accredited associate or bachelor’s degree program to be eligible for the scholarship.

MCH Foundation Healthcare Scholarship – Lake Crystal

This \$500 renewable scholarship is available for Lake Crystal Wellcome Memorial High School seniors who are pursuing a career in healthcare. Students must be accepted in an accredited associate or bachelor’s degree program to be eligible for the scholarship.
