Watch for Stock the Shelf volunteers pushing Sunshine Foods shopping carts and hand them your donation. The volunteers collecting for the Madelia Food Shelf will be in the first part of the parade, after the Madelia Community Hospital & Clinic float. Cash donations will also be accepted.

What items are needed at the Madelia Food Shelf? Canned meats and vegetables, tomato sauce, soups, hot and cold cereal, spices, cooking oil, condiments, rice and pasta, cleaning supplies, and other personal care items like shampoo, toothpaste and toilet paper.
