

Madelia Community Hospital & Clinic (“Hospital”) offers financial assistance under its Financial Assistance Policy.

Financial assistance will be given to an individual whose total income meets the following criteria. Total income includes the annual income of the individual and all working adults who reside with them.

- Total Income less than 100% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) = 100% financial assistance
- Total Income greater than 100% of FPG but less than 200% of FPG = partial financial assistance based on the following formula.
 - $\text{Discount} = 1.75 - [(0.75 \div \text{FPG}) \times \text{Income}]$
- Total Income greater than 200% of FPG = no financial assistance

An individual may be required to sell recreational vehicles to pay their liability to Hospital before the individual can qualify for financial assistance.

Financial assistance is limited to emergency medical care and other medically necessary care. Physician charges may not be eligible for financial assistance. See the Financial Assistance Policy for a list of physicians who are and are not eligible for financial assistance.

An individual who qualifies for financial assistance will not be required to pay more for emergency medical care and other medically necessary care than the amount generally billed to individuals who have insurance covering such care.
